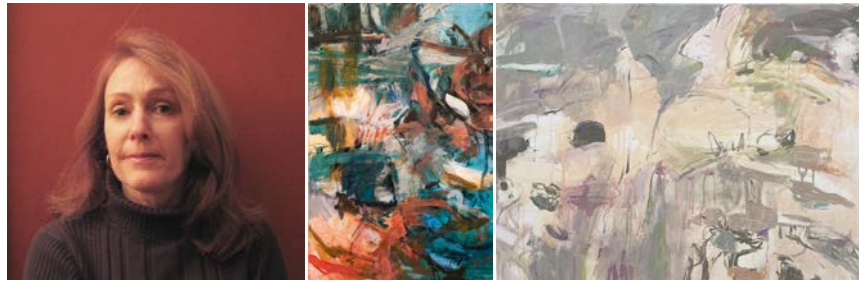


Nancy Karpf
