Instructions for Setting Up Your Individual Artist's Page on the Guild's Website

Exhibiting and Associate Members Only

1. In a word processing program, create a biography about yourself - written in the third person. This may include a list of awards, educational degrees, membership affiliations, publications and your artistic philosophy. (Read other artists' bios on the website to get a sense of style, content and length.)

Please note: We do no include links to personal or commercial websites or mentions of galleries that represent your work that are within the Guild's regional area.

- 2. Prepare up to 10 gallery images that represent your work.
 - a. They should be JPEG images between 800 and 1048 pixels in the longest direction.
 - b. The preferred resolution is 72 ppi (pixels per inch).
 - C. If you wish the title of your artwork to appear beneath each image, it needs to be the title of the JPEG exactly as you wish it to appear. For example: *The Tree on the Hill.jpg*.
 - d. The JPEG's must be <u>attached</u> to your email, not <u>inserted</u> within your email.
 - e. Please make your choices thoughtfully because it is timeconsuming for the Webmaster to make subsequent changes. Unless there is a major stylistic change in your work, changes will not be permitted.
- 3. Indicate whether you are an Exhibiting or Associate member and when you achieved that status. Also state your medium (e.g., oil, acrylic, photo, wood, etc.).
