Presidents' Message from the Guild's Co-Presidents David Levy and Barbara Russo dlevy1939@gmail.com

As we look into the Guild's gallery, we are rewarded with our exquisite September exhibit titled: **The Jersey Six: Women Together; Contemporary Realism**. The abundant technical prowess of these six artists is complemented by their originality, fine and thoughtful compositions, and impactful messages. The end result is an extraordinary exhibit and a wonderful experience to behold.

177 people attended the *Jersey Six* reception, along with many browsers and docent groups. All attested to the excellence of this show. Congratulations to the *Jersey Six*: **Daphne Hobson, Beth Bauer-Flancbaum, Sherly Bennett, Elizabeth Diamond, Laurie Flannery**, and **Carole Rogers.** Be sure to come to the Guild to see this exhibit before closing day on September 26th.

Notable, as well, are the works by the Guild's Associate and Exhibiting members that grace our lobby. One of the privileges afforded these membership levels is the opportunity to display works in our lobby. Month after month, the lobby walls are replete with the finest of art by our middle and top membership level artists. Those of us who work at the Guild always appreciate being surrounded by these stunning pieces of artwork created by the Guild's elite artists.

If you would like to become an Associate or Exhibiting member of the Guild, our **Semi-Annual Portfolio Review will take place November 16th through 18th**. Those interested in elevating their membership status and extending their exhibiting privileges should click <u>HERE</u> to go to the Guild website. Once there, scroll down to the bottom of the page for Portfolio Review information. The feedback from the jury members helps artists understand how other Exhibiting members view their work. The judges' insight illuminates the artist's strongest points, and, perhaps, point out those aspects that might be improved. Please call the Guild if you are planning to submit so we can schedule an appointment for receiving your artwork. After November, the next portfolio review is scheduled for May 2024.

One of the Guild's signature events of the year is on the horizon: **The 31**st **Annual Open Juried Show**. Our esteemed judges, **Gina Torello** and **Phil Echo**, have selected from the 224 submissions approximately 100 works to grace our gallery walls. The reception and presentation of awards will take place on October 1^{st} from 3:00 - 5:00. The awards presentation will begin at 4:00. Award money totals over \$2,000. If history is a true indication, this exhibit should be an outstanding one.

Speaking of Gina Torello, she will be teaching at the Guild a class titled **Painting the Human Form, A Fine Arts Course**. This four week course will meet on Friday mornings from 10:00 until 12:00. Fall, winter, and spring sessions are planned. Click <u>HERE</u> for information.

In October, the Guild also presents the annual **Art in Bloom** exhibit. Floral designers select a piece of artwork from the Open Juried Show and create a living, floral counterpart. As flowers are short lived, the exhibit is only on view October 14th through 17th, with a reception on October 15th from 2:00 to 4:00 PM. (Take note of the change from our normal reception times.) Come to the Guild and see the magic of these creations.

We are entering the home stretch of our fiscal year. We have remained solvent and vibrant throughout the year, due in part from our members sending in their yearly membership fee in a timely manner. 2024 membership fees are now payable, and due by January 31, 2024. Dues revenue, plus tuitions from classes in our new studio and plein air, as well as the grants we have received all contribute to our mission: To advance excellence in the Visual arts. Our most heartfelt thanks go out to all of our members and volunteers for helping us to grow and to prosper. We could not survive without you.



Gina Torello earned her M.F.A in Florence, Italy from the Dominican University in Chicago Illinois. She taught at Boardman Studios, an undergraduate Academy in Florence, Italy.

Gina is an active Board of Trustee Member on the Monmouth Arts Organization here in Monmouth County, and an Adjunct Professor at Monmouth University. She teaches at many local art institutions in our county, including the Guild of Creative Art.

Gina's fine arts class, **Painting the Human Form**, will be held on Friday mornings from 10:00-12:00. This course is designed to guide each student in painting the human form in oils, but students may utilize their favorite medium, such as acrylics or pastels. Students will strengthen their anatomical drawing skills and their understanding of how light wraps around the human figure.

Students will experience the enjoyable and fulfilling process of creating beautiful and unique works of art. Students can expect to complete one painting a week, rotating their position in the classroom throughout the four weeks in order to capture various perspectives of the model. All artistic and ability levels are welcomed into this course. Individual artists will be instructed at their stage of experience. Bring your favorite supplies, as this course welcomes oils, acrylics and pastels.

Students will supply their own materials. Minimum canvas size is 20"x16". Gina will be instructing in oils, however, if you prefer working in pastels or acrylic, please bring all materials for the medium you choose.

A <u>cash-only</u> model fee for all four class sessions will be collected on the first day of the first class.

Annual All Member Holiday Show

This year's All Member Show in our Main Gallery will receive artwork on <u>November 30th</u>. *Receiving opens at noon and closes promptly at 7:00 pm. No work will be accepted before or after that date and those times.* Click <u>HERE</u> for Show Submission Forms to expedite your registration process. All Guild members whose dues are paid in full for the current year may enter one or two works no longer than 48 inches on any side. The entry fee is \$5.00 per piece. The show will run through December. <u>The Guild will retain a 33.3% commission on all sales.</u>




Cousins by Beth Bauer-Flancbaum – Oil


















