By the time you read this, our Edgy Show will have passed, but if ever there were a time when Guild artists thought outside the box, and away from their comfort zones, this exhibit was proof positive. The 89 pieces on display were innovative, avant-garde, provocative, and weirdly "edgy!"

Kudos to Shrewsbury Mayor Kim Doran Eulner who graciously agreed to join Barbara Russo and me in judging this show. Fortunately, Kim was able to attend the reception to hand out awards. She graciously made time out of her busy schedule to mingle with artists afterwards. We loved having her! We also extend our thanks to all the Guild members and non-members who took the Edgy Show challenge. This was easily the "edgiest" show on record!

Next up: Our **Exhibiting and Associate Members' Show**, which runs from January 31st until February 24th. The opening reception will take place Sunday, February 1st from 3:00 - 5:00 PM. All of the artists who are part of this exhibit have participated in our Semi-Annual Portfolio Review and have been able to elevate their membership status. Achieving Associate or Exhibiting membership level offers greater opportunities to display your artwork, a constructive critique from your peers, and feedback that we, as artists, seldom receive. Keep in mind that the next opportunity for the Portfolio Review will be this May. Call the Guild to reserve your spot for receiving on Thursday, May 14th as judging will take place on Friday May 15th. Pickup, as always, is the following day, Saturday, May 16th.

Our **EyeSights 2026 Open Juried Photography Show** follows during the month of March (February 28th - March 25th, with a reception on March 1st from 3:00- 5:00 PM. **The online submission period ends precisely at midnight, January 30th.** This is the premier photography show in our area, and with over \$1500 in award monies and ten Medals of Achievement, competition is always fierce.

Our esteemed EyeSights judge is Jackie Dickert. Jackie has the difficult task of selecting about 100 pieces that will appear in the show from the hundreds of submissions that will be received. She will also decide on the award winners. We know she is up to the challenge. This is always an exciting event. We thank all who submitted photos and wish them the best of luck!

We finished our calendar year with over 400 members, and, with a flurry of donations during December, we were once again, able to finish the year "in the black." Of course, the life of a nonprofit organization is never easy. With the new year, the funding challenge begins again. We urge our members to renew their membership dues as soon as possible. Winter expenses, like snow removal and heat, are always rising. Renewing your membership in January or February can help the Guild keep ahead of those mounting costs. 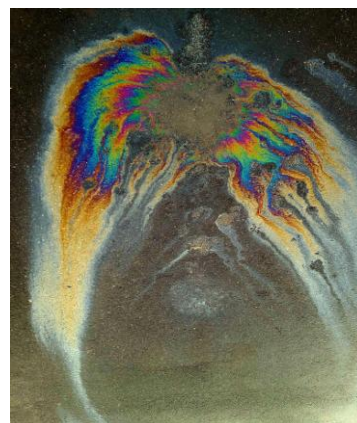
